CLASS INFO: FIRST DAY OF CLASS: Children meet their enrichment teacher at the **lunch shelter** immediately after school is dismissed the first day of the session. After the first day, students meet at the assigned location.
PICK UP: Children need to be picked up at their designated class area, immediately after class is dismissed. Failure to pick up your child on time could result in dismissal from the program without a refund.
ABSENCES: Please notify Conejo Community Center at 805-495-2163 if your child will be absent from their recreation class. Attendance is taken in each class and absences are verified.
RAINY DAYS: Rain or bad weather does not cancel programs. Programs will be moved to an indoor area.
HOLIDAYS: No programs are held on school holidays, pupil free days, or school minimum days.
Children may be dismissed from the program without a refund due to behavior problems.

REFUNDS:

Cancellations by the Participant

- * A full refund will be granted if the district is notified at least one (1) working day prior to the start of the program.
- * **Refunds will not be granted once a class has begun. Students may not "try out" a class.**
- * Refunds for medical reasons will be granted on a pro-rata basis subject to written certification of such reasons by a physician.

Cancellations by Conejo Recreation & Park District

- * A full refund will be made in the event that a class is cancelled by the district prior to the starting date.
- * A partial refund will be made on a pro-rata basis if the activity is cancelled prior to the conclusion of the program.

Kindergarten Classes: Students will be picked up in their classroom and walked to after school program. Parents do not need to pick up their student until programs are dismissed at 2:30pm.
